The World Trade Center (WTC) is a global hub connecting businesses, institutions, and professionals through a trusted international network. Licensed by the **World Trade Centers Association** (WTCA), founded in 1968, the network spans over 300 cities in more than 90 countries, with over 1 million affiliated companies. The World Trade Center Kozhikode will be the largest in India and one of the largest in the world. Spanning 12.5 million sq. ft. with an investment of \$680 million, the development will feature seven towers, including a dedicated Education Tower, creating a powerful blend of business, trade, education, and lifestyle.

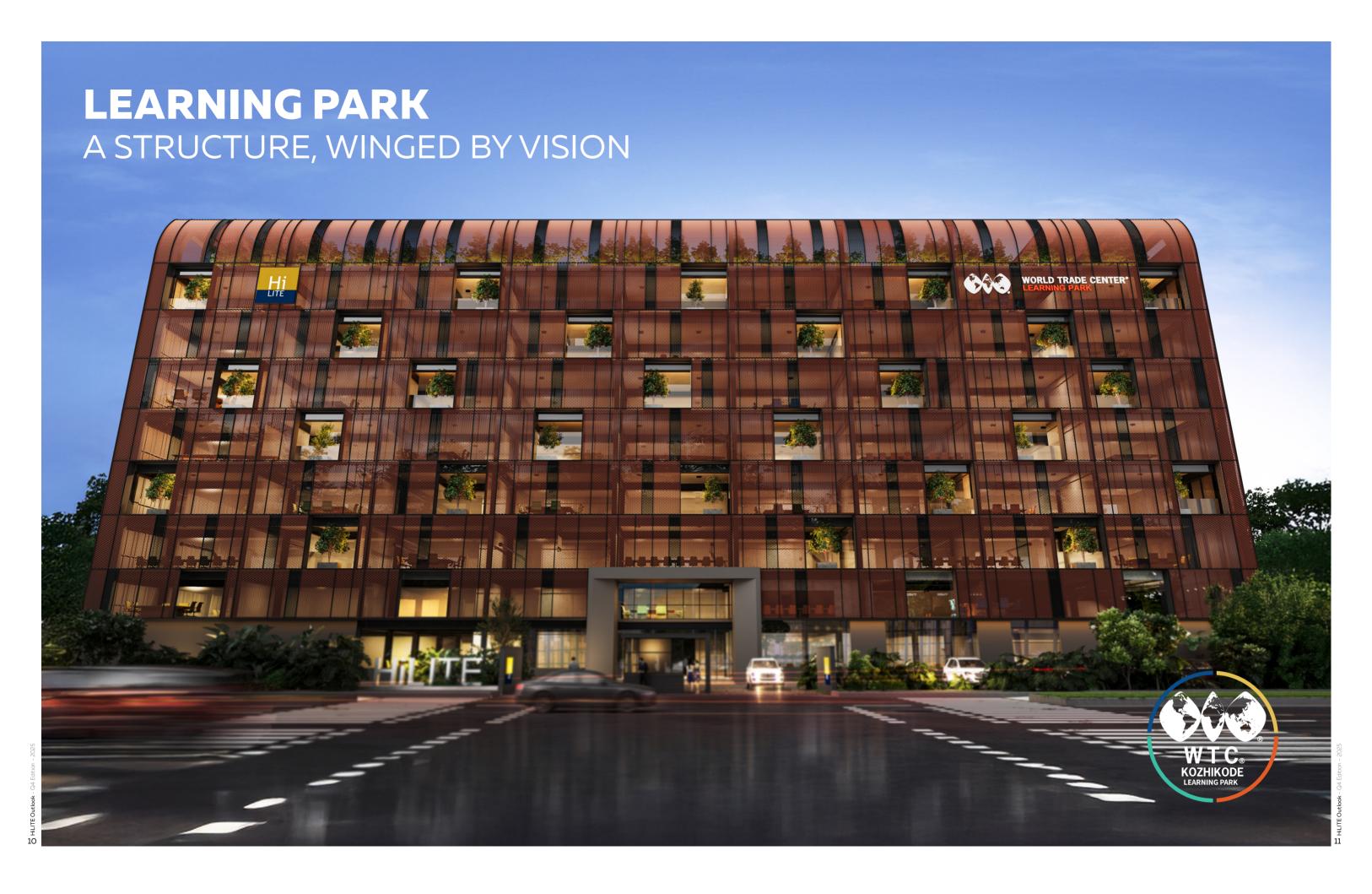

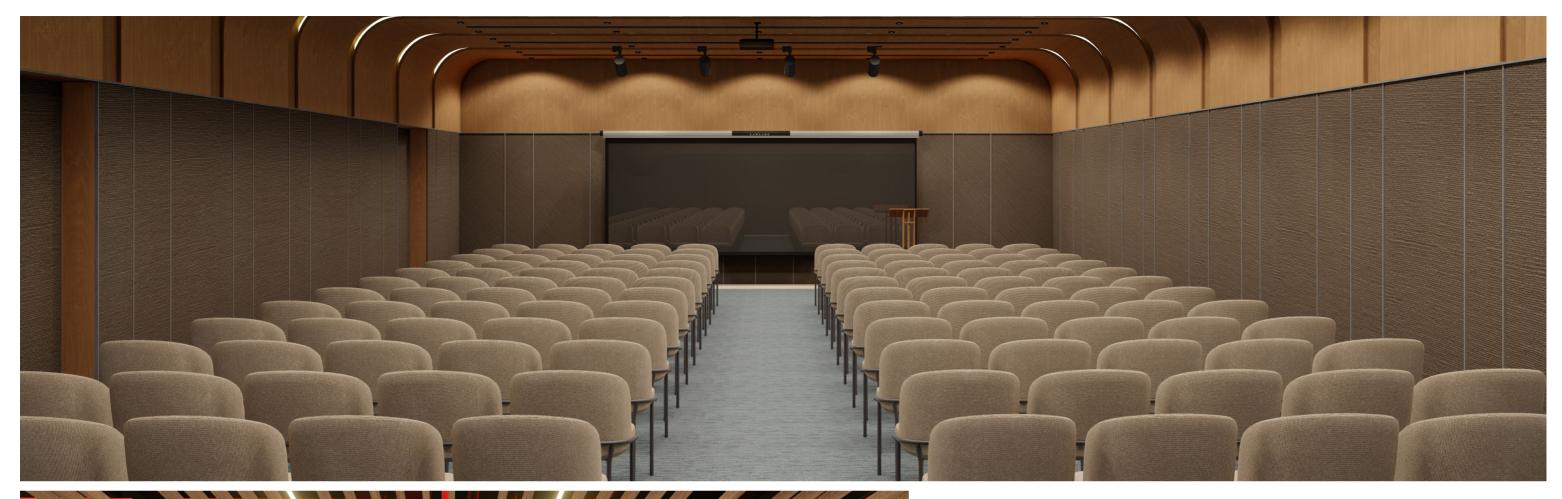

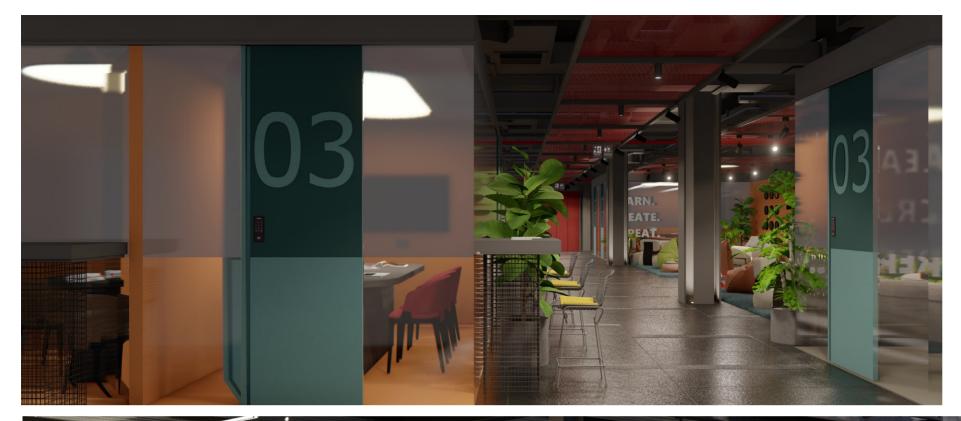

## WHEN THE WORLD TRADE CENTER

### **BUILDS KOZHIKODE**

#### **The Story**

Necessity is the mother of invention, and the original World Trade Center was a suggestion of American economist and investment banker David Rockefeller. Why? Because in the late 1940s and 50s, economic growth in New York was concentrated in Midtown Manhattan. To stimulate urban renewal in Lower Manhattan, he suggested the construction of a large complex, which was later conceptualised as the World Trade Center. What began as a visionary response to urban challenges soon evolved into a global movement.

The whole city will awaken to new possibilities of growth. Growth of this scale needs huge support, and when we discussed the project, the stakeholders, government officials, other authorities and the general community responded positively. This gave us the grit to begin the project ahead of timeline. The trust we have built with society has brought us here.

#### **The World Trade Center Effect**

World Trade Center Kozhikode is unique for its sheer scale and features. Envisioned as more than just office spaces, it will include a learning park facilitating co-learning, a luxury hotel and serviced apartments, convention centers, integrated retail zones, residential communities, exclusive clubs, performance theatres and much more. By anticipating future needs, this project is designed as a complete ecosystem, one that fosters commerce, innovation, and quality living in equal measure.

Such a presence creates a platform to attract international companies. Kozhikode already has a strong trade and business culture, but a World Trade Center takes this to the next level by providing a structured ecosystem that global corporations seek. When international companies decide to establish themselves in a new



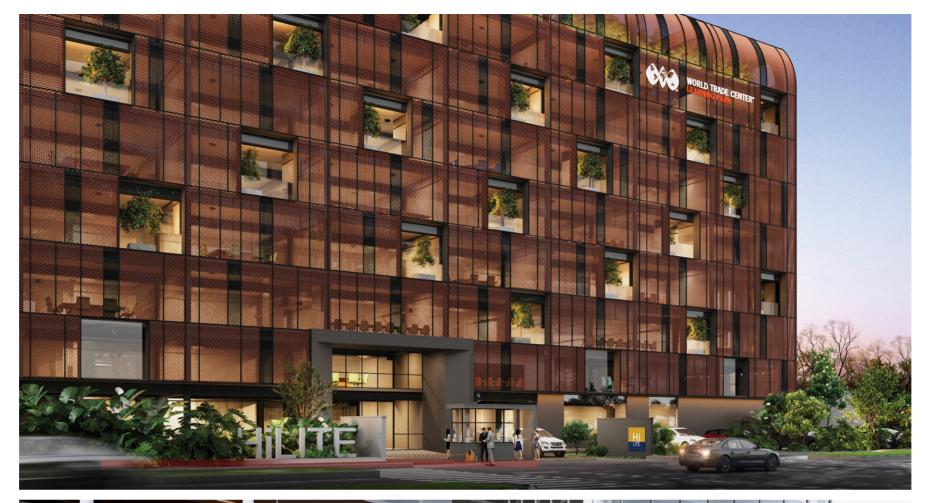
location, they study the host country's political, legal, and cultural environment. A WTC reassures them that the city is ready. It sends a signal of confidence that the region can welcome alobally acclaimed corporations and institutions. In turn, this strengthens not just the city but the wider region it belongs to.

#### **Opportunities for Kerala**

Trends come and go in everything, but one that refuses to fade is the outflow of students and professionals from their homeland to foreign countries due to a lack of opportunities. Bringing opportunities to Kerala is the way to slow down this brain drain. For the fresh talent pools around us, WTC is the best we can offer.

WTC will bring global companies that actively seek skilled professionals. Kerala has a large untapped pool of young talent who can contribute meaningfully to growth. Even global brands need local professionals with native-language skills, market knowledge, and cultural insight. Beyond this, a development like WTC can also empower those who are talented but unemployed due to societal or personal constraints, for instance, women who have chosen family over migration. They can now build careers with world-class facilities and competitive salaries, all while staying close to their families

Another powerful effect is reverse migration. The recent changes in international rules and curbs on foreign visa applicants have had an adverse effect on those moving abroad in search of jobs. Several big companies scrambled to secure their overseas workers, exposing the vulnerability of migrating talent. If ecosystems like WTC had existed here, the scare of job loss and forced migration would have been far lesser. That is what we are building now.





Along with WTC, HiLITE will soon launch tech parks in Kochi, Trivandrum, Kozhikode, Thrissur, and Malappuram, and an industrial park, together creating a world-class ecosystem within Kerala. With opportunities at home, families can stay together while individuals pursue high-quality careers locally. This strengthens not just professional lives but also social structures.

#### **Transforming Everyday Life**

The presence of a WTC improves everyday life for local communities. The growth of IT parks in Kozhikode, for example, led to a surge in demand for apartments, hostels, restaurants, and local stores. Similarly, a World Trade Center will uplift small and medium businesses, creating fresh avenues for entrepreneurs and local suppliers. It also boosts revenues and reinvestment. A WTC increases tax inflows through the businesses it attracts. Governments can then reinvest in infrastructure and public services, better roads, utilities, and civic facilities, raising living standards in the region. Over time, this creates a virtuous cycle where global commerce and local development go hand in hand.

Equally important is cultural enrichment. With international companies and institutions setting up here, Kozhikode will welcome a vibrant diaspora. When cultures blend, cities flourish, broadening perspectives and inspiring creativity.

When I was in my final year of college in 2010, Kozhikode was only beginning to see organized commercial spaces take shape. Focus Mall had opened two vears earlier, and Mayoor Road, the city's busiest stretch, did not even have proper parking facilities. It was in that setting that HiLITE planned an office tower with 1,000 parking slots. Many criticized the idea and predicted it would fail. I often recall this and remind my team of the vision of our Chairman, P. Sulaiman. The beginning was indeed difficult because people did not yet understand what such a development meant. Looking back, it proved one thing: only long-term vision can make projects like the World Trade Center possible.

Before speaking about WTC, Business Park deserves mention. Its biggest challenge was not construction but communication. What is a Business Park? Why do companies need it? Convincing both people and businesses was critical. Without community support, no project can thrive, and without companies, no business model is sustainable. That is why we focused on creating an experience instead of simply selling spaces. Today, the same people who doubted HiLITE Business Park now value it, not as offices but as an ecosystem. This experience gives us confidence as we move towards WTC Kozhikode. Unlike the early days, people now understand the advantages of such developments much faster. WTC is not just another IT park; it rises beyond. A WTC license brings global credibility to a city, and its benefits begin long before the building is complete.

It's a place where strangers can become regulars, and regulars become friends.







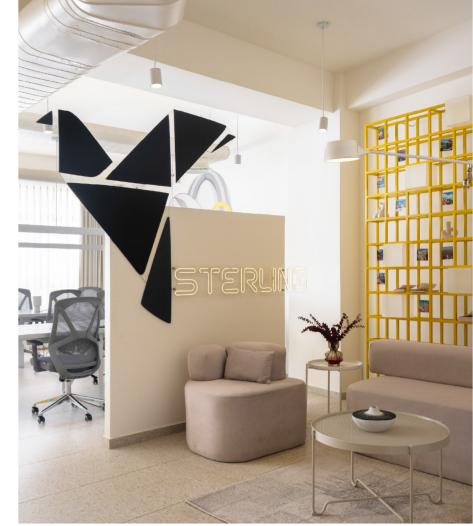

# THE SKY ISN'T ALWAYS BLUE

Mom: "Why are you crying?"

Child: "The teacher scolded me,"

Mom: "Why?"

Child: "Because I coloured the sky pink. She told me it's blue, not pink." Isn't the colour of the sky pink, Mamma?

Mom: "She is absolutely wrong! Paint the sky any colour you want."

Child: "Friends called me a fool. They said the sky is blue."

Mom: "Don't let anyone tell you what colour your sky should be. Everyone has their own sky. If your sky is pink, then make it pink."

Have you ever heard a child ask, "Why does the sky have to be blue?" or seen them paint a mountain with seven different colours just because it feels right to them? How often do we pause and truly listen instead of giving the usual "That's not how it is" reply?

As shown in the movie The Sky Is Pink, a child colouring the sky pink carries a bigger lesson about curiosity and choice. When we respond to a child's questions with interest rather than judgment, their wonder grows instead of fading. Each thoughtful answer becomes a stepping stone for a mind that dares to imagine bigger, explore further, and see the world in new ways. It is in these moments, free from the fear of being "wrong," that bright minds take shape.





Traditional education often emphasises memorisation, correctness, and fixed paths. While facts remain important, true learning unfolds when students have the freedom to question, experiment, and make their own choices. and reasoning—the very habits that shape innovators, leaders, and independent thinkers.

The real world rarely offers a single "correct" answer. Success depends on asking meaningful questions, adapting to change, and thinking creatively. Here, teachers play a transformative role: it takes courage to move beyond rigid lesson plans and create space for curiosity to lead the way.

So, the next time a child colours outside the lines, don't correct them, ask them why. Let them explain, explore, and experiment. Because sometimes, the sky isn't just blue, it's pink. And in that pink sky lies the beginning of imagination, discovery, and lifelong learning.

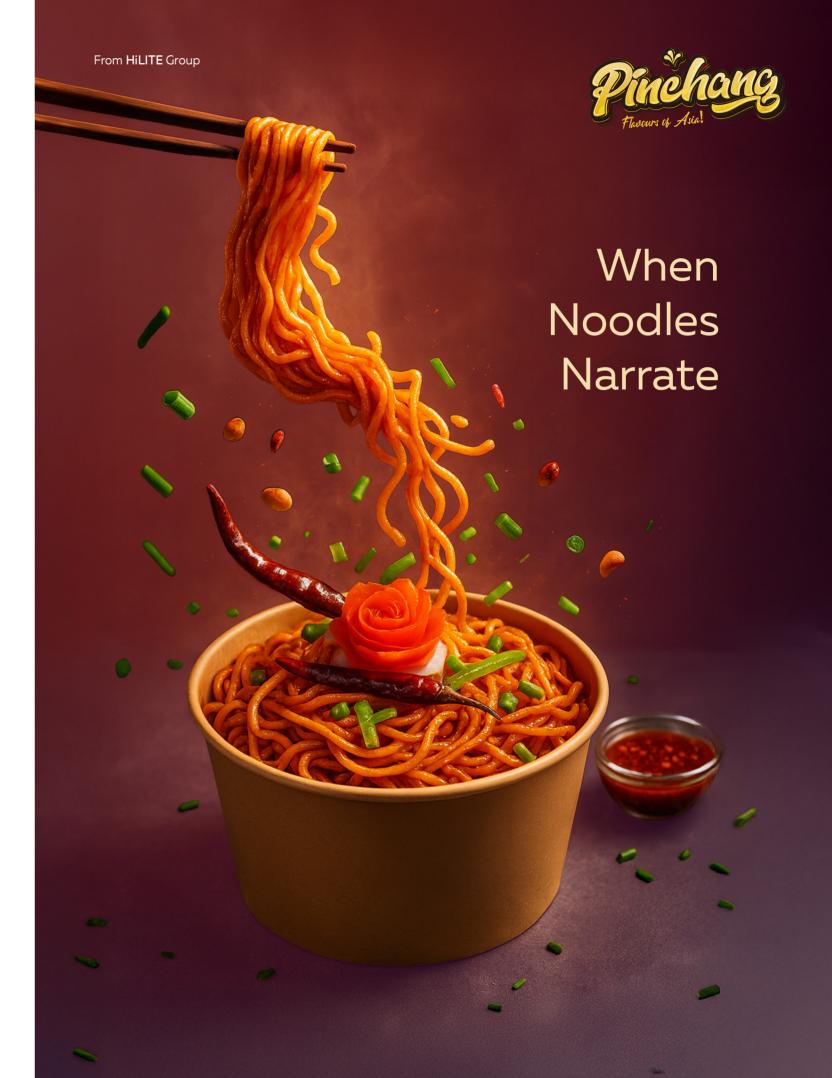

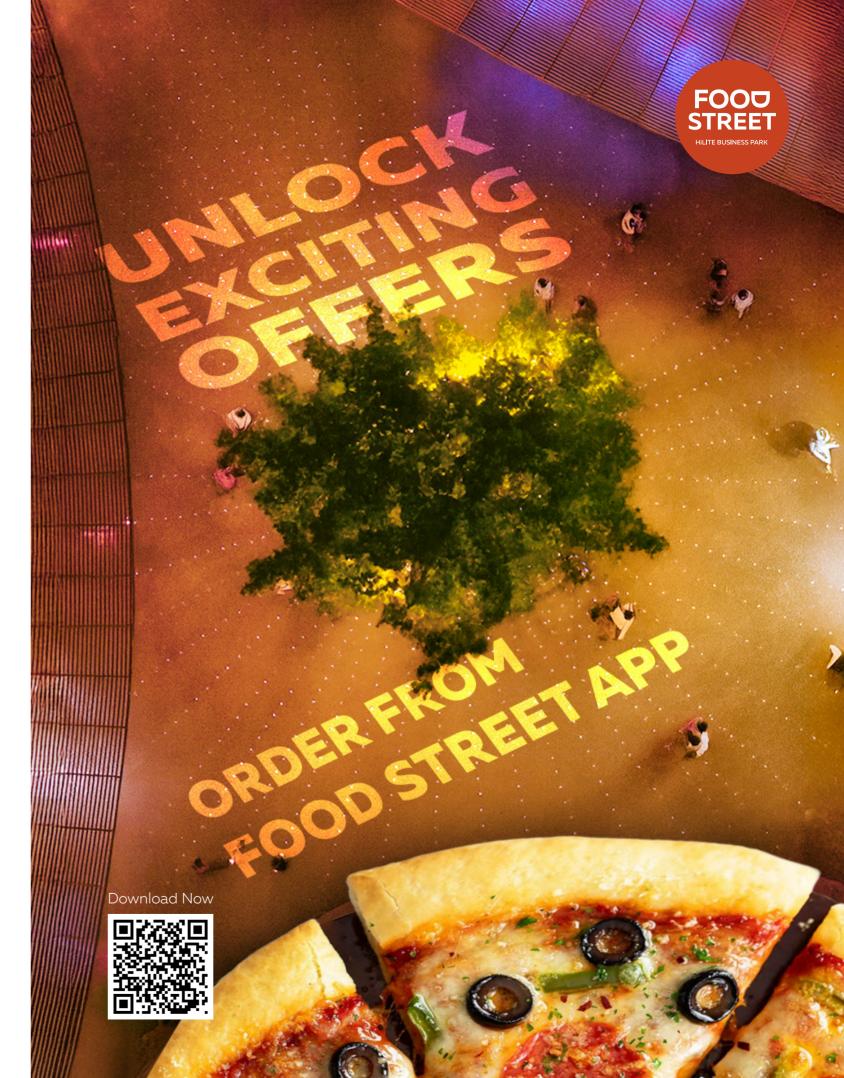
